

- 19:00 Hot springs pools are open 24 hours



BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

APPROVAL: Upon paying for your itinerary/invoice you agree you have checked the itinerary and confirm that all details are correct including the names you have provided as they appear on passports, as well as dates, times, and destinations, and you agree to the t&c's outlined below.

PAYMENT: All U.S. travelers will pay the package price to the Hot Springs Association. The Hot Springs Association will then send bulk payment directly to the managing travel agency Travel Utopia in Australia.

PRICES: Prices are subject to change & availability until paid in full. Travel Utopia Pty Ltd acts as an agent to purchase travel arrangements on your behalf and has no control over price changes.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travel documents include (without limitation) airline tickets, hotel vouchers, tour vouchers or any other document (whether in electronic form or otherwise) used to confirm an arrangement with a service provider. Travel documents may be subject to certain conditions and/or restrictions including (without limitation) being non-refundable, non-date changeable, non transferable and subject to cancellation and/or amendment fees. All airline tickets must be issued in the name of the passport/photo ID holder, some carriers will deny carriage if the name varies from your passport/ID.
